

Sermon Discussion Questions for August 18, 2019

Mission – Be on Mission to the Next Generation – Psalm 78:2-7

1. What key point stood out to you in the message?
 2. Pastor Andrew described Liberty as being a “3 chair church.” What did he mean by this? Why do churches neglect reaching new generations with the gospel?
 3. Pastor Andrew gave 4 “B’s” of being on mission to the next generation. What was the first one (Be Inviting)? How do we think like a guest thinks about their church experience? If we invite a guest, what are our expectations for our church’s treatment of the guest? Do we help meet those expectations week in and week out? How can Liberty do a better job?
 4. What was the second “Be”? (Be connecting). What makes Liberty unique when it comes to forming relationships? What did Robert Putnam say about “bowling alone” and how does that relate to the importance of connecting with others?
 5. Third “B”? (Be Giving). Describe your understanding of “faithful legacy of giving.” In church stewardship, do we give to receive? How does our giving at Liberty resemble the “pay it forward” concept?
 6. Last “B” is _____? (Be Serving). What does 1 Peter 4:10 say about serving? What unique gift has God given you to serve? Are you using your gift at Liberty? In the community? In the World? Do you serve the next generation (nursery, preschool, students)?
